

**7 RICCARTON ROAD
STATEMENT OF LYNETTE ANDRELL**

I am the manager of the Night & Day Dairy, 11 Riccarton Road, which is owned by my father.

The Night & Day Dairy was next door to the bookshop which was situated in the building at 7 Riccarton Road.

I did not give the building at 7 Riccarton Road a lot of thought before and really after the September 2010 earthquake, other than to think that it was an old building.

I did go into the bookshop a couple of times after the September earthquake and brought books.

I know that it was yellow stickered at some stage after the September earthquake because I saw the sticker on the front of the shop and saw that the shop was closed because of the earthquake.

I recall that some time later the shop re-opened and the manager and his female assistant were working there, wearing hardhats and high visibility vests. This went on for a couple of weeks.

This was definitely not in the period immediately after the earthquake but sometime later after the shop had been closed because of the yellow sticker and then re-opened.

I recall thinking that it was odd that they were wearing those items if the building was presumably safe enough to be open for business.
