

## David Reynolds

David Reynolds is Director of Reynolds and Associates, a consultancy established in 2007 which provides cultural heritage management services to territorial authorities, heritage agencies, museums and individual owners of heritage assets.

David's interest in New Zealand prehistory led him to complete a BA in archaeology and he worked for 13 years at Auckland Museum as a museum educator, involved with the interpretation of museum collections. This was followed by 17 years with the NZ Historic Places Trust, initially as Regional Officer where he gained experience in the assessment and protection of scheduled and registered heritage buildings and the techniques of adaptation and repair.

As Northern Regional Property Manager for the Trust, he managed the day to day operations, staffing, interpretation, conservation and maintenance of the Trust's 30 North Island properties, including house museums, archaeological sites, lighthouses and other heritage structures.

The founding chairman of ICOMOS New Zealand (the New Zealand National Committee of the International Council on Monuments and Sites), he is currently a member of its Executive Board. He is a member of The Association for Preservation Technology, and Museums Aotearoa.
