## STATEMENT OF CLAIM

THE Plaintiff by its Solicitor says:

8 COC 1. THAT the First Defenant is registered as proprietor of 21 that parcel of land containing 460 square metres or thereabouts being of part of Town Sections 805 and 806 , Town christchurch and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of mitle Register 25 K Folio 953 (YCanterbury Land Registry) subject to Mortgage 648169/1.
2. THAT the second Defendant is registered as proprietor of all that parcel of land containing 537 square metres or thereabouts being of part of Town Sections 805 and 806 , Town of Christchurch and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title Register 25 K Folio 952 (Canterbury Land Registry) subject to Mortgage 648171/1.
3. THAT pursuant to a written contract dated the 3 ra of November, 1986 the plaintiff contracted with WILLIAMS CONSTRUCTION CANTERBURY LIMITED that subject to certain conditions of contract and allowable extras and variations the plaintiff would supply for the intended development by the First and Second Defendants of a property at 249 Madras Street, Christchurch all the strutural steel and metal work for a total price of $\$ 56,499.00$ exclusive of GST.
4. THAT on a date unknown to the plaintiff the obligations on the part of WILLIAMS CONSTRUCTION CANTERBURY LIMITED were assigned to the Third Defendant who became at law and in equity the Head Contractor in respect of the development.
5. THAT on divers dates between the 5 th of December, 1986 and the 18 th of May, 1988 the plaintiff carried out its terms of contract and supplied labour and materials in performance of the structural steel and metal work part of the development.
6. THE total amount payable to the plaintiff inclusive of extras, variation and GST was $\$ 77,474.69$.
7. THAT the Third Defendant has paid the plaintiff $\$ 69,248.00$ such there remains due and owing to the plaintiff the sum of $\$ 8,262.21$ which sum is now due and owing by Third Defendant to the plaintiff.
such moneys and has incurred interest charges to its bank for provision for overaraft finance.
9. THE rate which the Plaintiff's Banker charges interest on its overdraft varies from time to time.
10. THAT Notice in writing of the Plaintiff's claim under the Wages protection and Contractors' Liens Act, 1939 of a lien on the said lands and a charge on the moneys payable or to become payable by the First and Second Defendants to the Third Defendant under the terms and conditions of the head contract between the First and second Defendants and the Third Defendant was duly given by the Plaintiff to the First and Second Defendants on the 1st day of June, 1988.
11. THAT written notice of having claimed such liens and charges was duly given by the plaintiff to the Third Defendant on the 1 st day of June, 1988.

WHEREFOR the Plaintiff claims:
a. A declaration that it is entitled to a lien under the Wages Protection and Contractors' Liens Act, 1939 on the estates and interests of the First and second Defendants' land described in paragraphs 1 and 2 hereof for the sum of $\$ 8,262.21$, interest as claimed herein and the costs of and incidental to this action and the registration of the said liens.
b. An Order directing the sale of the First and Second Defendants' lands.


In order directing the First and Second Defendants pay to the plaintiff the amount of such charge.

Judgment against the First and Second Defendants for the sum of $\$ 8,262.21$, interest at the rate from time to time payable by the plaintiff to its bankers for overdraft accommodation from such date as may to this Honourable Court seem just and costs pursuant to Section $31(2)$ of the said Act.
f. Judgment against the Third Defendant for the sum of $\$ 8,262.21$, interest at the rate from time to time payable by the plaintiff to its bankers for overdraft accommodation from such date as may to this Honourable Court seem just and costs pursuant to section $31(2)$ of the said Act.
g. Such further or other relief as may to this Honourable Court seem just.
