9. Students shall be persons not under sixteen years of age who are or have been pupils, apprentices, or assistants under agreement of Corporate Members of this Institution or of Engineers of standing recognized as such by the Council, or who are Engineering Cadets in the service of the Government or of any local authority, or who are receiving full-time instruction in an engineering school or college, or are undergoing such other similar experience and/or tuition as may be approved by the Council and have received or intend to receive regular training in some one of the Branches constituting the profession of an engineer and have passed such examinations or acquired such standard of attainment in the subjects of general education as may be prescribed by the Council's rules for the time being, but whose qualifications at the time of application for admission do not satisfy the provision of Rule 8 for Graduates.

Except as hereinbefore provided, no person shall be admitted or remain a Student after the completion of the calendar year in which he attains the age of twenty-eight, except that the Council may at its discretion and to meet unusual circumstances extend this age limit to thirty years.
