STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE OF ROBERT GAIMSTER IN RESPECT OF THE CTV BUILDING

Qualifications and Experience

- 1. My full name is Robert Gaimster. I reside in Palmerston North and am the Chief Executive Officer for the Cement and Concrete Association of New Zealand (CCANZ). I have a B.Eng in Civil Engineering (Portsmouth Polytechnic/University) and am a Chartered Civil Engineer (MICE) with the Institution of Civil Engineers. I have an Advanced Diploma in Concrete Technology and am a member of the UK based Institute of Concrete Technology. I am a former President of the Institute of Concrete Technology and an examiner for some ten years. I also have an MBA, (AMBA accredited).
- 2. I have been employed by the Cement and Concrete Association of New Zealand since November 2006 and have been its Chief Executive since November 2008. Since November 2009 I have been a board director of the Building and Construction Industry Training Organisation.
- 3. Between 1988 and 2005 I was employed by RMC Group Plc, a multinational cement and concrete products manufacturer and marketer and held the position of National Technical & Operations Manager from 2003 to 2005. From 2005 to November 2006 I was employed by Cemex UK Materials, a global cement and building products manufacturer and marketer as National Technical Manager.

Purpose of Evidence

I have been asked to give evidence of the submission by CCANZ (dated 30 April 2012) on the Hyland Fatigue and Earthquake Engineering/ Structure Smith CTV Building Collapse Investigation Report and the Hyland Fatigue and Earthquake Engineering CTV Site Examination and Materials Report, in relation to concrete testing carried out on various columns from the CTV building.
